

Dear visitor,

at an altitude of 549m and not even 60 km from Vienna, the "Wanderwelt Steinwandklamm" is one of the most beautiful and definitely one of the most interesting ravines in Lower Austria.

After heavy rains or in spring, when the snow melts up in the mountains, you can admire the waterfalls and cascades walking along on our paths, bridges and staircases. The reason why there is not always that much water is the special ground the Steinwandklamm is situated on. It is surrounded by karst landscape which explains why all the rain disappears quickly in the grounds.

If there is not much water or none at all, it is still a spectacular walk through the romantic ravine and you can admire this unique place with its fauna and flora.

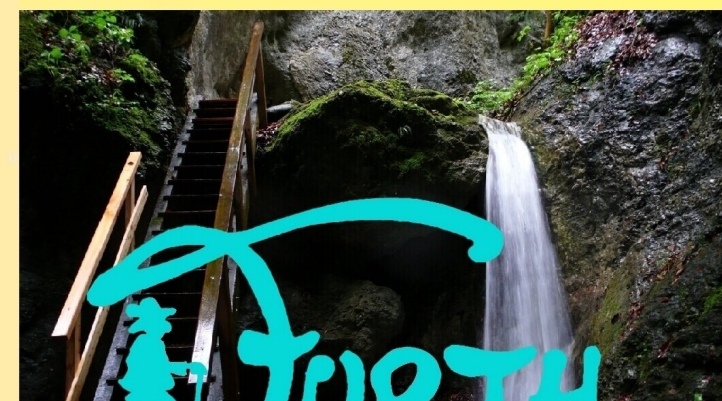
Especially on those hot summer days you will always find relief here in the cool ravine. Bring your children, grandchildren and your dog – they will all enjoy the shady spots. Mind the signs along the path: you will learn a lot about the animals and plants which you find in the Steinwandklamm. Many of them are protected species and not found very often anymore.

On the way through, just before you reach the top, you will see one of the really adventurous parts of the Steinwandklamm: the "Türkenloch". It is a cave which was once used as a shelter from the attacks of the Turks back in the 17th century. You can easily walk through the cave, it is not that long and once you are in, after a few steps, you can see the light on the other end. Just make sure you mind your head! Finally, on the very top (706m), you will enjoy the beautiful view down on the valley and after a short walk you can admire the "Schneeberg" on a clear day.

If you like real adventures and if you and whoever is with you are not afraid of height, you can climb the "Rudolf Decker - Steig". Be responsible and use a climbing kit for your children.

Be aware that you choose this path only if nobody in your group is afraid of climbing. One more important thing about the "Rudolf Decker - Steig": Because of the danger of falling stones you are allowed climbing UP only. Now all that is left for us to tell you is to have a great and relaxing day here with us! Enjoy our beautiful Steinwandklamm!
